

Independent Colleges Scholarship Scheme

Independent College Dublin and Event Strategies, organisers of the Event Industry Awards (www.eia.ie), are delighted to announce a new scholarship scheme for the College's evening Diploma in Event Management. The scholarship, which is worth €1,650 per annum, is open to all those who aspire to work in the event management industry and who wish to study for a PRII (Public Relations Institute of Ireland) accredited diploma within the next academic year.

Scholarships are offered on the basis of merit. To be awarded a scholarship, students must show evidence of work experience and / or professional interest in the area of study that they wish to pursue.

Applicants must submit a 1,000 word essay on '*The contemporary relevance of the Event Management industry for the Irish economy*'. Entries will be judged by a panel of industry experts including Eugene Bortolozzo, managing director of Event Strategies, Eleanor Kenyon and Anne McGynn, course directors, and Ronan Traynor of Verve Marketing.

Eligibility to apply:

- You are over 18 on the 1st of January of the year of entry
- You have submitted an Application Form and a copy of your most recent Curriculum Vitae
- You are legally entitled to remain in the country for the full duration of your chosen course without the requirement of a study visa.

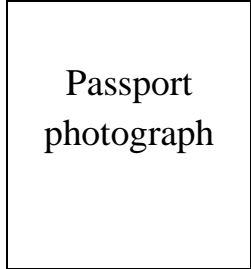
